The 14th Annual Mariachi Vargas Extravaganza is a 7-day mariachi music festival with a Christmas-themed Mariachi Serenade on the Riverwalk and an opening mariachi Mass at the historical San Jose Mission.

The largest and most competitive mariachi group and vocal competitions are held during the festival at the Municipal Auditorium as well as a mariachi-themed art exhibit at the Centro Cultural Aztlán. Highlighting the event is a concert featuring the world renowned and Mexico City based Mariachi Vargas de Tecalitlán who celebrates 111 years of mariachi music tradition this year.
