These outstanding groups and vocalists earned a spot in tonight's show by placing first in the Mariachi Extravaganza Competitions earlier today. More than 300 students from 7 different states and Canada participated in the inaugural Mariachi Extravaganza Las Vegas.



GRAND CHAMPIONS

Every year in San Antonio, the Mariachi Extravaganza crowns one competitor as the "Best in the U.S. Grand Champion Vocalist". Tonight you will witness award performances former winning by champions Kaylee Bucio from Utah (2019), and Nayelli Pena (2022) and Lorraine Garza from Texas (2024).



JONATHAN PALOMAR

Jonathan Palomar, one of the greatest vocalists in mariachi history, headlines the event. Formerly a key member of the world-renowned Mariachi Vargas de Tecalitlán, Jonathan's powerful voice and emotional depth have made him a beloved figure in mariachi music across the globe. Tonight, he will be accompanied by UNLV's Mariachi Revolucion.



Jonathan Palomar

Jonathan Palomar is a singer and guitarist from Mexico City. Born into a musical family from Ameca, Jalisco, he started playing music at a young age. His first music teacher was his father, Don Rafael Palomar, who taught him both singing and guitar. At the age of eight, he expanded his training with private lessons in piano and guitar. At 17, he joined the Escuela Libre de Música in Mexico City, where he studied classical singing and guitar.

In 2017, he was invited to join Mariachi Vargas de Tecalitlán (the best mariachi in the world). Since then, Jonathan has had a busy touring schedule in Mexico, the U.S., Canada, Europe, South America, and Asia, as well as recording projects. He participated in Luis Miguel's "México por Siempre" tour in 2018, 2019, and 2023. The tour won both the Latin Grammy and the International Grammy. Palomar has performed with Mariachi Vargas in over 450 concerts worldwide, including iconic venues such as: El Palacio de Bellas Artes, Auditorio Nacional, Teatro Degollado, the UN Auditorium in Geneva, Switzerland, and even the White House in Washington, D.C.

Currently, Jonathan resides in San Antonio, Texas, where he serves as the Artistic Director of the Mariachi Extravaganza Conference (the largest of its kind in the world) and teaches music at educational institutions for students and teachers in Mariachi programs through nonprofit organizations. At the end of 2023, Jonathan decided to retire from Mariachi Vargas de Tecalitlán to focus on his solo career and further his musical studies at Our Lady of the Lake University, which generously awarded him a full scholarship for this purpose. He also continues to work as an educator of traditional Mexican music, sanctioned by UNESCO as one of the most important cultural heritages of Mexico.

MEET THE JUDGES OF THE VOCAL & GROUP COMPETITONS Jonathan Palomar, Jimmy Cuéllar & Adrian Mendoza

Jimmy Cuéllar is a proud alumni of UNLV where he studied music composition. He is a former member of the legendary Mariachi Los Camperos de Nati Cano and the current director of Mariachi Garibaldi de Jaime Cuéllar. He is a three-time Grammy Award-winning musician, composer, and arranger who is dedicated to preserving traditional mariachi music while embracing innovative styles. Cuéllar's versatile talent has led him to perform on NPR's Tiny Desk with pop star Camila Cabello, further showcasing his ability to bridge traditional mariachi with contemporary music. Under his dynamic leadership and creative vision, Mariachi Garibaldi continues to captivate audiences in both the U.S and Mexico with their show *Fiestas de Mexico*. Mariachi Garibaldi is currently touring with Miguel Peña's Ballet Folklorico del Rio Grande and will be performing *Fiesta Sinfónica* con Mariachi Garibaldi on Saturday, March 22, at the Segerstrom Concert Hall in Costa Mesa, CA.



Adrian Mendoza is a highly respected trumpet player based in Las Vegas and known for his exceptional skill and dedication to mariachi music. From 2013 to 2018, he toured and recorded with the acclaimed Mariachi Sol de México and was nominated for a Latin Grammy. Adrian has also performed with the world-renowned Mariachi Vargas de Tecalitlán during the Luis Miguel tour, further solidifying his reputation as a top-tier mariachi musician. Currently, he serves as a master trumpet instructor for Clark County ISD, where he is deeply committed to nurturing young talent and promoting mariachi education throughout the district. His passion for teaching is complemented by his family's strong musical roots. His first teacher was his own grandfather and his wife is a mariachi director at Chayanne High School and a former member of the trailblazing allfemale ensemble Mariachi Reyna de Los Angeles.
